KNOTS USED

Double lark head knot
Berry knot
Square knot
doublé half-hitch knot

STEP BY STEP:

STEP 1: Cut a 2m piece of rope. Then, fold the macrame cord and use a double lark's head knot to attach the cord to the wooden dowel as you can see in the pictures.



STEP 2: Cut the macrame cord into 11 lengths of rope that are 1.30m long. Then, fold all of the macrame cords in half and use a lark's head knot to attach the cords to the loop of the cord attached in the previous step.



STEP 3: In total there should be 24 cords. With the 4 cords to the right make a berry knot: make 3 consecutive square knots, then take the two middle cords and weave it through the hole at the top of the first square knot, and finally tie a square knot to lock in the berry knot.



STEP 4: With each group of 4 ropes make a berry knot. Make 6 berry knots in this first row.



STEP 5: With the 4 central ropes make one more berry knot.



STEP 6: Cut the macrame cord into 3 lengths of rope that are 3m long to get them on the right side. Then, fold all of the macrame cords in half and use a lark's head knot to attach the cords to the wooden dowel.



STEP 7: Grab the 4th rope on the right, this will be the lead cord. We work a doublé half-hitch knot diagonally on this lead cord with the 3 next right cords and then with the 2 cords to the left.



STEP 8: Grab the 3rd rope on the left, this will be now the lead cord. Work a doublé half-hitch knot diagonally on this lead cord with the 2 next left cords and then with 2 cords to the right.



STEP 9: Repeat three times more the steps 7 and 8.



STEP 10: Grab the last lead cord and make one more doublé half-hitch knot diagonally. Then grab the 3rd rope on the left (our new lead cord) and work a doublé half-hitch knot diagonally on this lead cord with the 2 next left cords.



STEP 11: Do the same for the other side symmetrically (steps 6 to 10).



STEP 12: Join the strings from the sides and work with the 6 central strings. Grab the 3rd rope on the left, this will be the lead cord. Work a doublé half-hitch knot diagonally on this lead cord with the 3 next right cords and then with 2 cords to the left.



STEP 13: Grab the 3rd rope on the left, this will be the lead cord. Work a doublé half-hitch knot diagonally on this lead cord with the 2 next left cords and then with 3 cords to the right.



STEP 14: Cut it with the form of a "V".



STEP 15: Add the 22 cm ropes on the sides (from what we have cut in the previous step). In the four loops of each diamond include two of these ropes using a lark knot.



WASHING ADVICE

Always wash in as warm a water temperature as possible - up to the temperature recommended, with a short spin. Use a lot of water if hand washing. For darker colours we recommend the use of discolouration sheets.

Do not bleach.

Do not tumble dry. Drip-dry on a horizontal surface.

Iron on a hot temperature setting using a damp cloth.

Professional dry cleaning in tetrachloroethylene.

STEP 16: Unravel the rope's ends and with the help of the comb, brush them. **You can comb only the 24 strings attached for a rustic style (image 1) or also comb the 22 cm strings included in step 15 (image 2).** **Cut a piece of rope that's 1m.** Tie each end of the cord to the two sides of the wooden dowel to hang the macrame project.
