## MATERIALS

**Schachenmayr Catania Trend**, 50 g ball approx. 50 g ≈ 125 m

Col. 00422 (lavendel) 2, 3, 3, 4, 5 balls  
 Col. 00247 (wolke) 1, 2, 2, 2, 3 balls  
 Col. 00440 (karamell) 1, 1, 1, 1, 2 balls  
 Col. 00252 (kamelie) 1, 1, 1, 1, 2 balls  
 Col. 00222 (orchidee) 1, 1, 1, 1, 2 balls  
 Col. 00418 (greenery) 1, 1, 1, 1, 2 balls  
 Col. 00391 (petrol) 1, 1, 1, 1, 2 balls  
 Col. 00200 (yodagrün) 1, 1, 1, 1, 2 balls

Yarn amounts are approximate. Make sure to purchase enough of the same dye lot in order to complete your project. The colour names refer to the German names on the sleeves. The amount of yarn needed can vary from person to person.

Size 3.5 mm circular needle (US size 4), 80 cm and 40 cm long

1 crochet hook 3.5 mm (US size 9/10)

1 tapestry needle for weaving in ends

## GAUGE

**Lace pattern, needle size 3.5 mm:**

16 st and 32 rows = 10 x 10 cm

## THE BASICS

**Ribbed pattern:**

Garner stitch: Knit every row.

## Lace pattern:

**N 1:** selvedge st, k1, \*yarnover, slip 1 st knitwise, k1, pass the slipped st over\*, k1, selvedge st

**N 2 and 4:** selvedge st, purl st and yarnover, selvedge st

**N 3:** selvedge st, k1, \*k2tog, yarnover\*, k1, selvedge st  
 Repeat from \* to \*.

Work R 1 - 4 throughout.

**Color sequence 1:** (right back and front)

Alternate 14/14/16/16/16 rows in Wolke and Lavendel

**Color sequence 2:** (left back and front)

Work 28/28/32/32/32 rows \*karamell, kamelie, orchidee, greenery, petrol and yodagrün, repeat from \*.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Instructions are for smallest size, with changes for larger sizes noted in different colors. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

NOTE:

Work two parts for back and front, then sew the two parts together.

## Left back

Using Lavendel, cast on 60/64/68/72/76 st and work 2 cm in ribbed pattern, in the last R increase 20 st evenly spaced = 40/44/48/52/56 st.

Continue working in lace pattern according to color sequence 2.

For sleeve shaping, when the piece measures 34/35/36/39/42 cm from the cast-on edge, at the left-hand edge, cast on 12 st = 52/56/60/64/68 st.

For neck shaping, when the piece measures 50/52/54/58/62 cm from the cast-on edge, at the right-hand edge, bind off 9 st and then every other row 1x 3 st and 1x 2 st.

When the piece measures 52/54/56/60/64 cm from the cast-on edge, bind off the remaining 38/42/46/50/54 st.





### Right back

Work in mirror to the left back, but work according to color sequence 1. Work the increases for sleeve shaping at the right-hand edge and the decreases for neck shaping at the left-hand edge.

### Left front

Using Lavendel, cast on 60/64/68/72/76 st and work 2 cm in ribbed pattern, in the last R increase 20 st evenly spaced = 40/44/48/52/56 st.

Continue working in lace pattern according to color sequence 2.

For sleeve shaping, when the piece measures 34/35/36/39/42 cm from the cast-on edge, at the right-hand edge, cast on 12 st = 52/56/60/64/68 st.

At the same time, for slit shaping, when the piece measures 34/36/38/42/46 cm from the cast-on edge, bind off 4 st at the left-hand edge = 48/52/56/60/64 st.

For neck shaping, when the piece measures 43/45/47/51/55 cm from the cast-on edge, bind off 4 st at the left-hand edge and then every other row 1x 2 st and 4x 1 st.

When the piece measures 52/54/56/60/64 cm from the cast-on edge, bind off the remaining 38/42/46/50/54 st.

### Right front

Work in mirror to the left front, but work according to color sequence 1. Work the increases for sleeve shaping at the left-hand edge and the decreases for slit and neck shaping at the right-hand edge.

### FINISHING OFF

Dampen and block the pieces according the measurements; allow to dry.

Sew the right and left back together.

Sew the right and left front together, leaving the slit open.

Sew the shoulder seams.

Sew the side and sleeve seams, leaving the bottom 12 cm open.

Work in Lavendel 1 row single crochet at the slit edges, securing the ends with it.

### Slit border at the front

Using Lavendel, pick up 22 st at the slit edge and work 1.5 cm in ribbed pattern. Bind off the st. Repeat at the other slit edge.

### Neckband

Using Lavendel, pick up 80 st at the neckline and the short border edges and work 2 cm in ribbed pattern. Then knit and bind off the st loosely.

### Border at the sleeves

Using Lavendel, pick up 78/82/86/90/94 st at the sleeve edge and join in the round. Work 2 cm in ribbed pattern. Then knit and bind off the st loosely.

Weave in all ends.

### ABBREVIATIONS

- k = knit
- p = purl
- R = row(s)
- RS = right side
- st = stitch(es)
- WS = wrong side
